### Glossary

- **DPP** = Diabetes Prevention Program, an evidence-based program proven to decrease risk of developing diabetes. It is the gold standard lifestyle change program for supporting people who have prediabetes and working to decrease their risk of diabetes.
- **MDHHS – Diabetes & Kidney Unit** = A part of MDHHS in the Public Health Administration and within the Division of Chronic Disease and Injury Control; sits in the Diabetes and Other Chronic Diseases Section. Oversees what we refer to as the State of Michigan Diabetes Prevention and Control Program.
