

 - MDPP Expanded Model: Findings at a Glance
 - MDPP has high retention rates and association with weight loss, however, reach of the program has been limited. Although an estimated 16 million Americans 65 years of age or older are eligible for MDPP, fewer than 10,000 beneficiaries have participated in MDPP.
