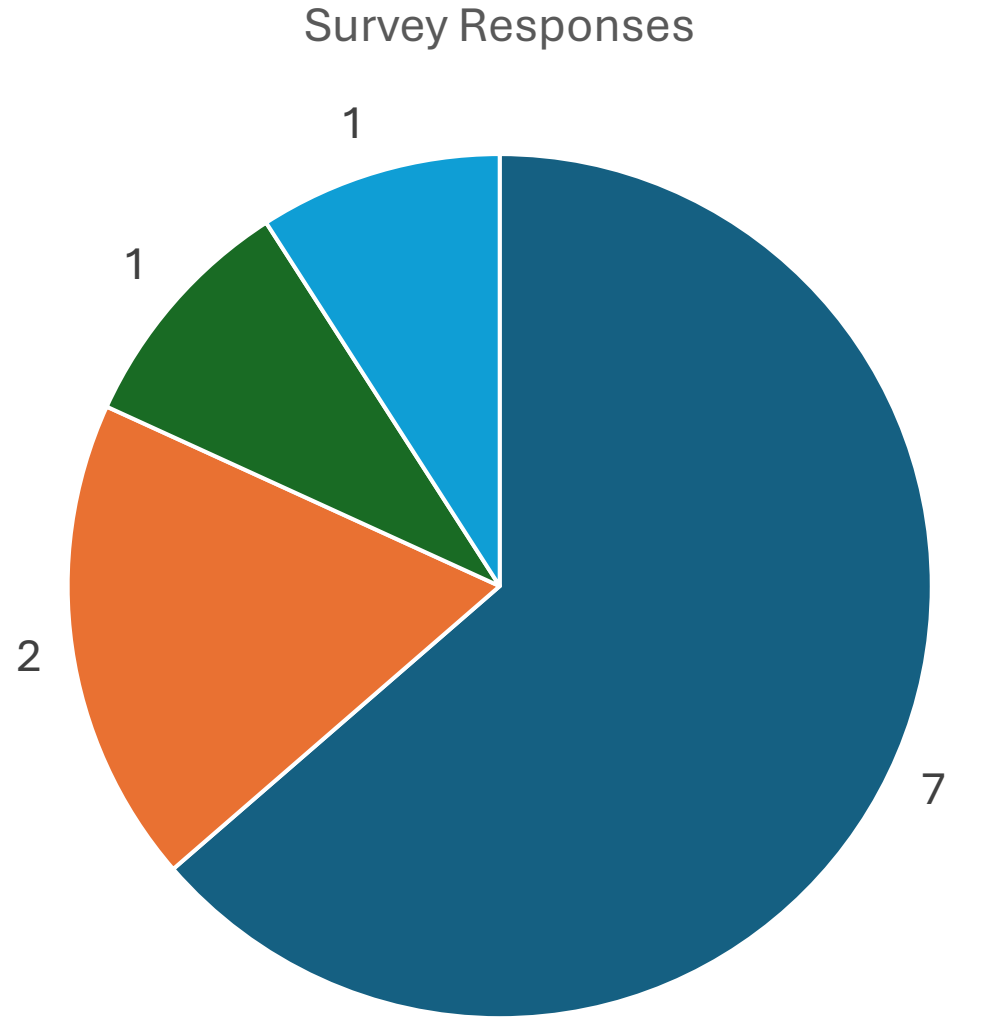

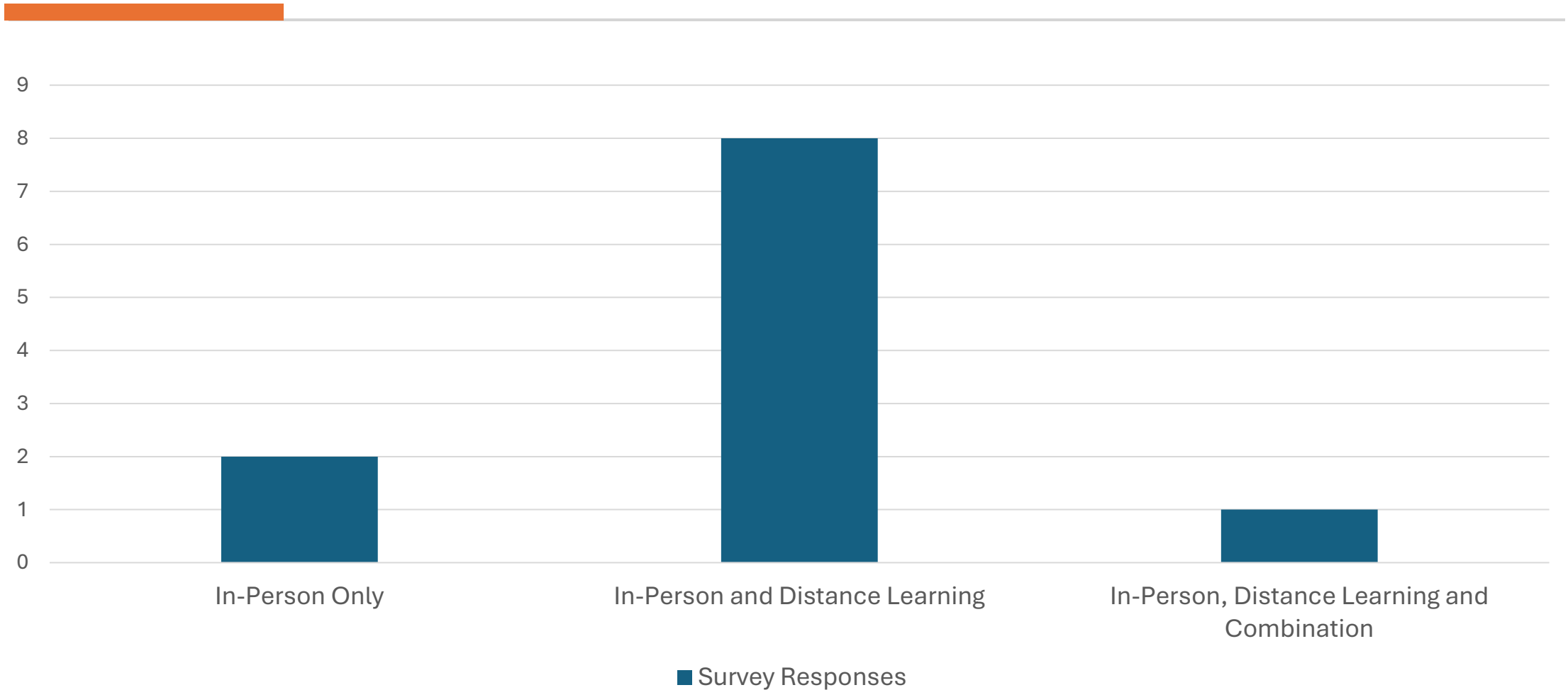

- 100% of respondents said that their organization's DPP was currently "active".

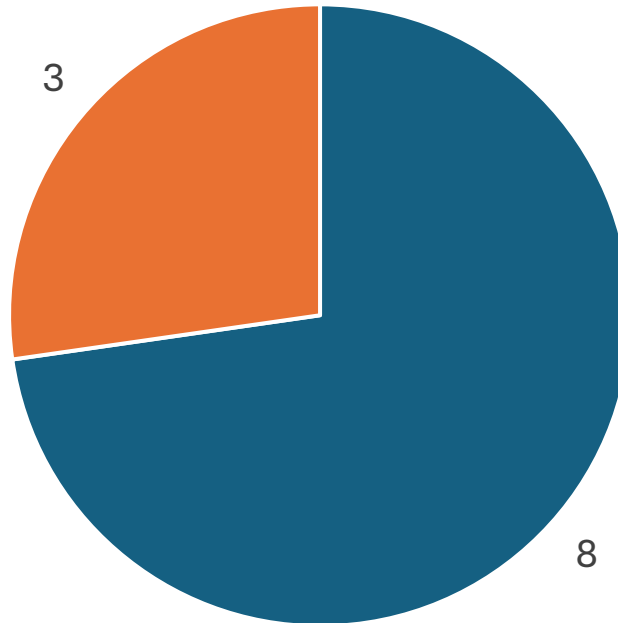
Delivery modalities



Medicare DPP Supplier Status

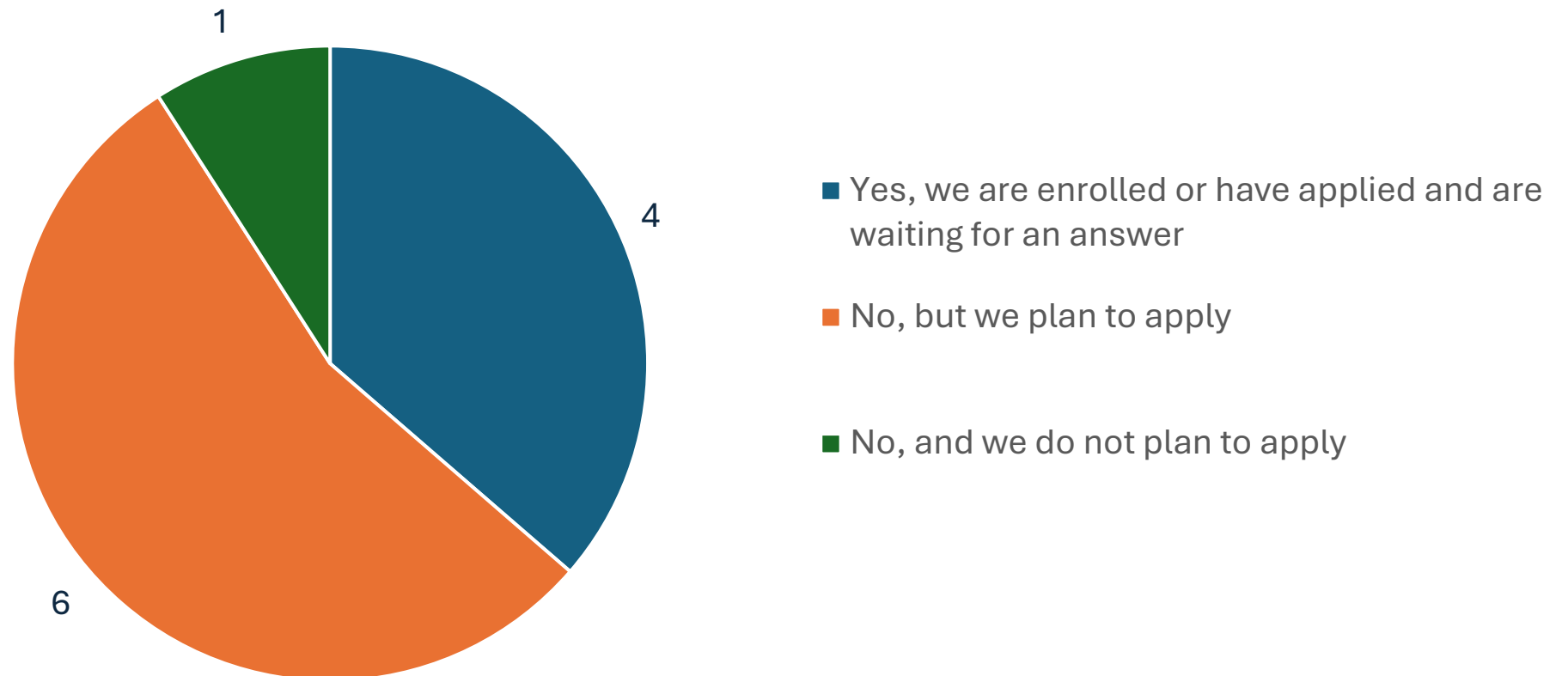

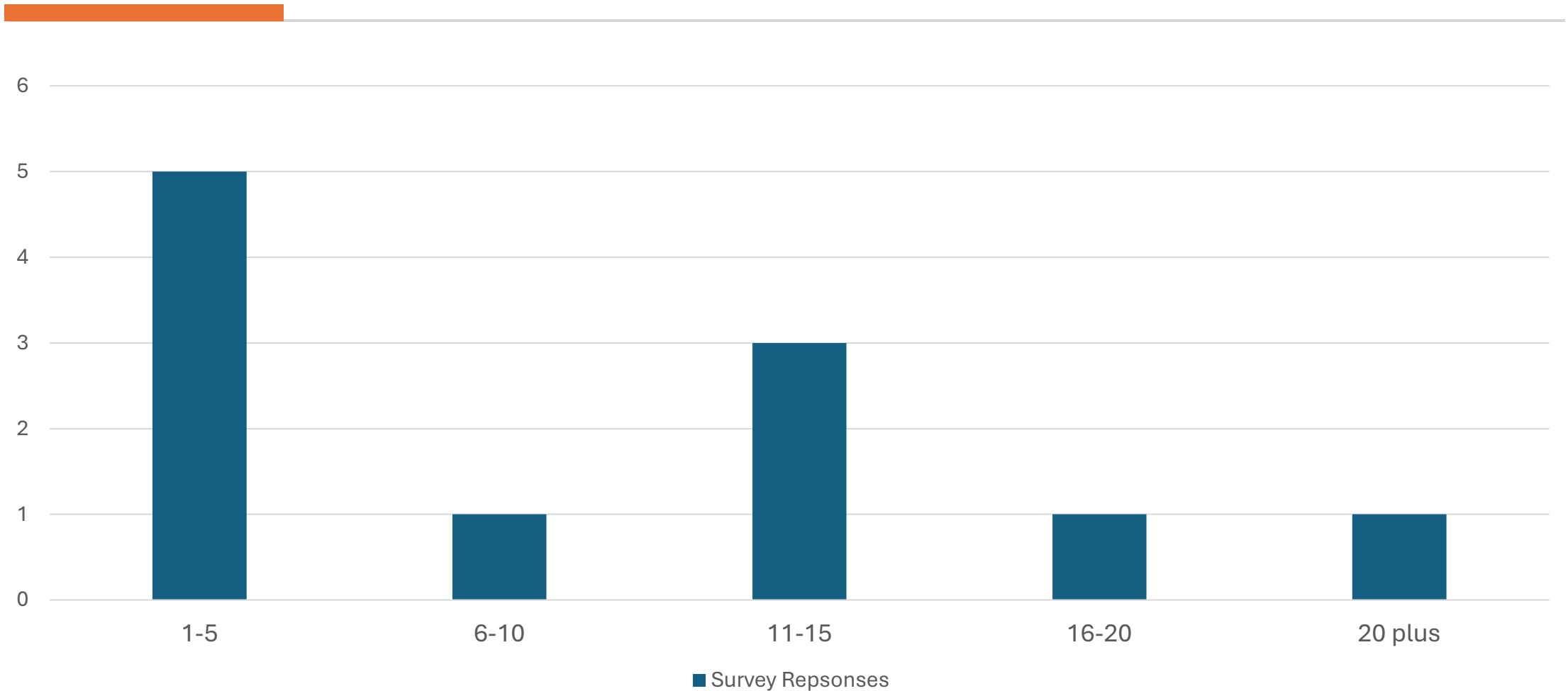


Michigan Medicaid MiDPP Status

- Make physical activity part of the curriculum. 2. Update the data collection process-change the way physical activity minutes are averaged so they don't start counting into the average until after lesson 4 when we talk about physical activity. Otherwise they have to get an average of 175 minutes for the remaining 18 sessions. 3. Make a sheet that cannot be changed and only allows for data entry that people have to fill out so no errors can occur in the data submission process
- Getting more referrals from primary care doctors
- Recognize diabetes programs not attached to a physical hospital
- Easier approach for coverage of program

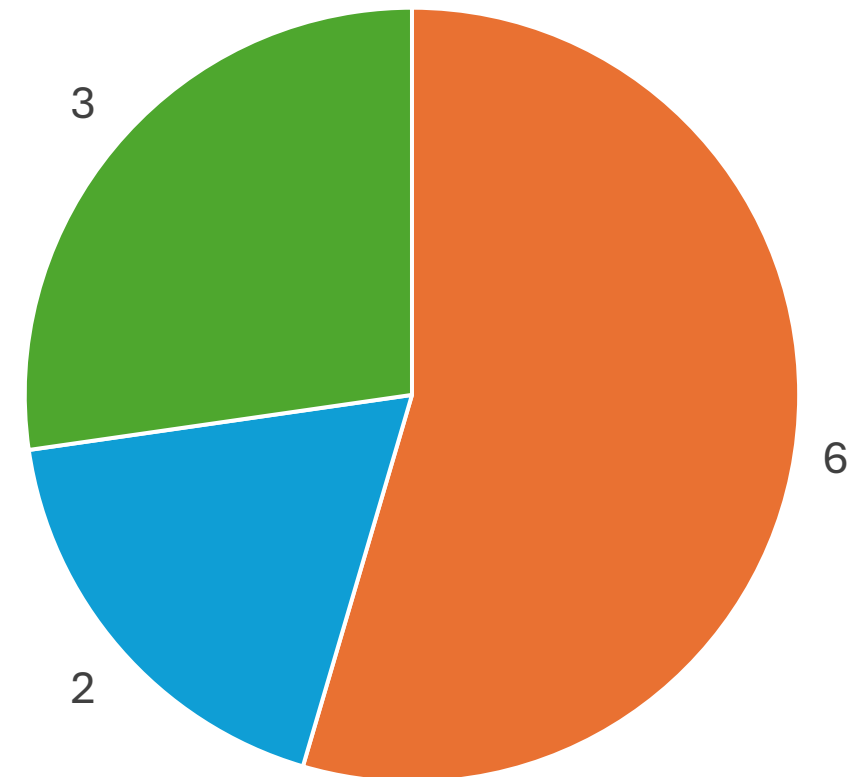

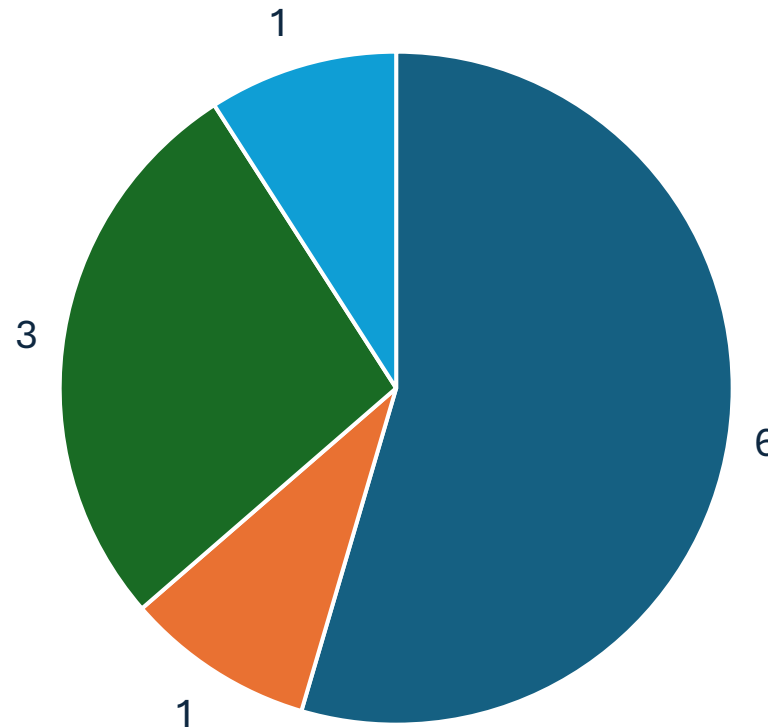

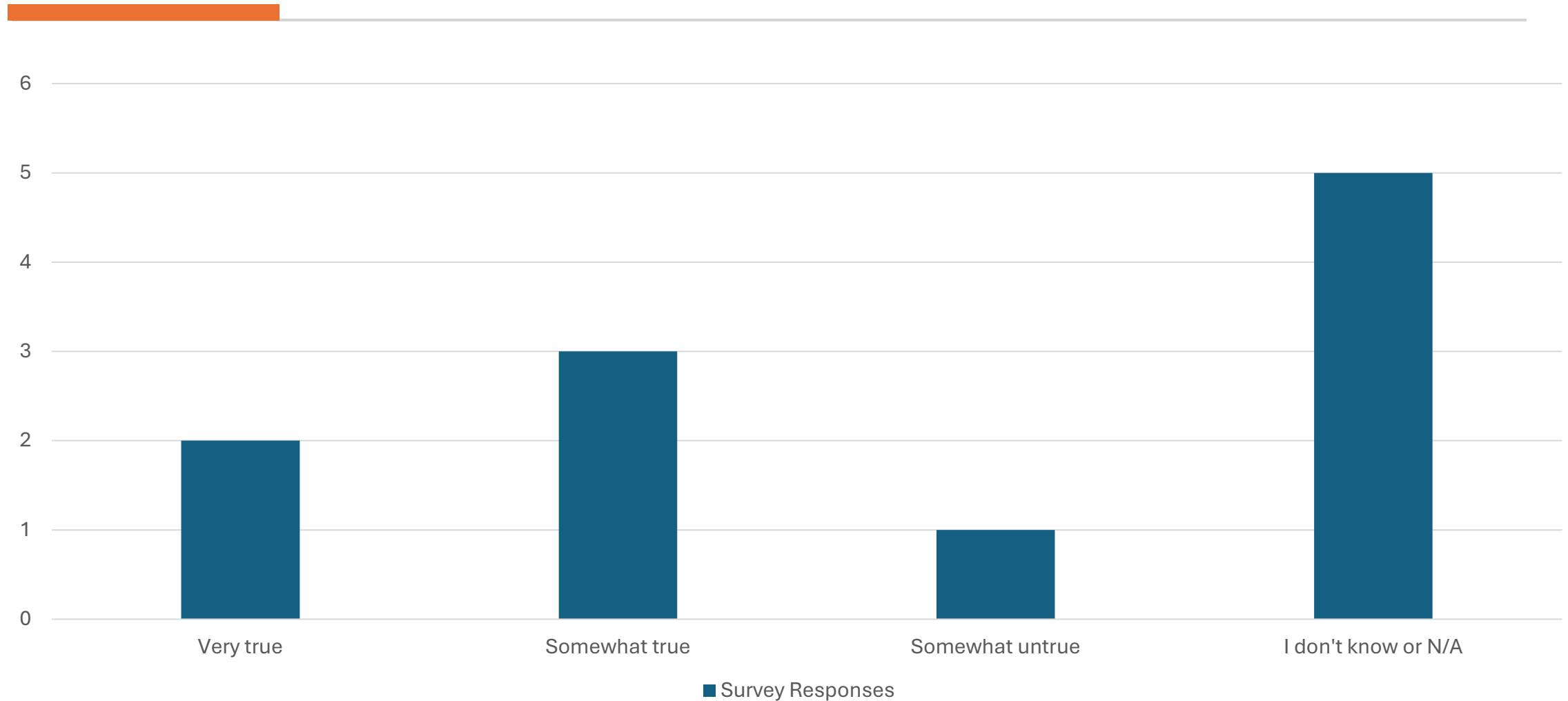

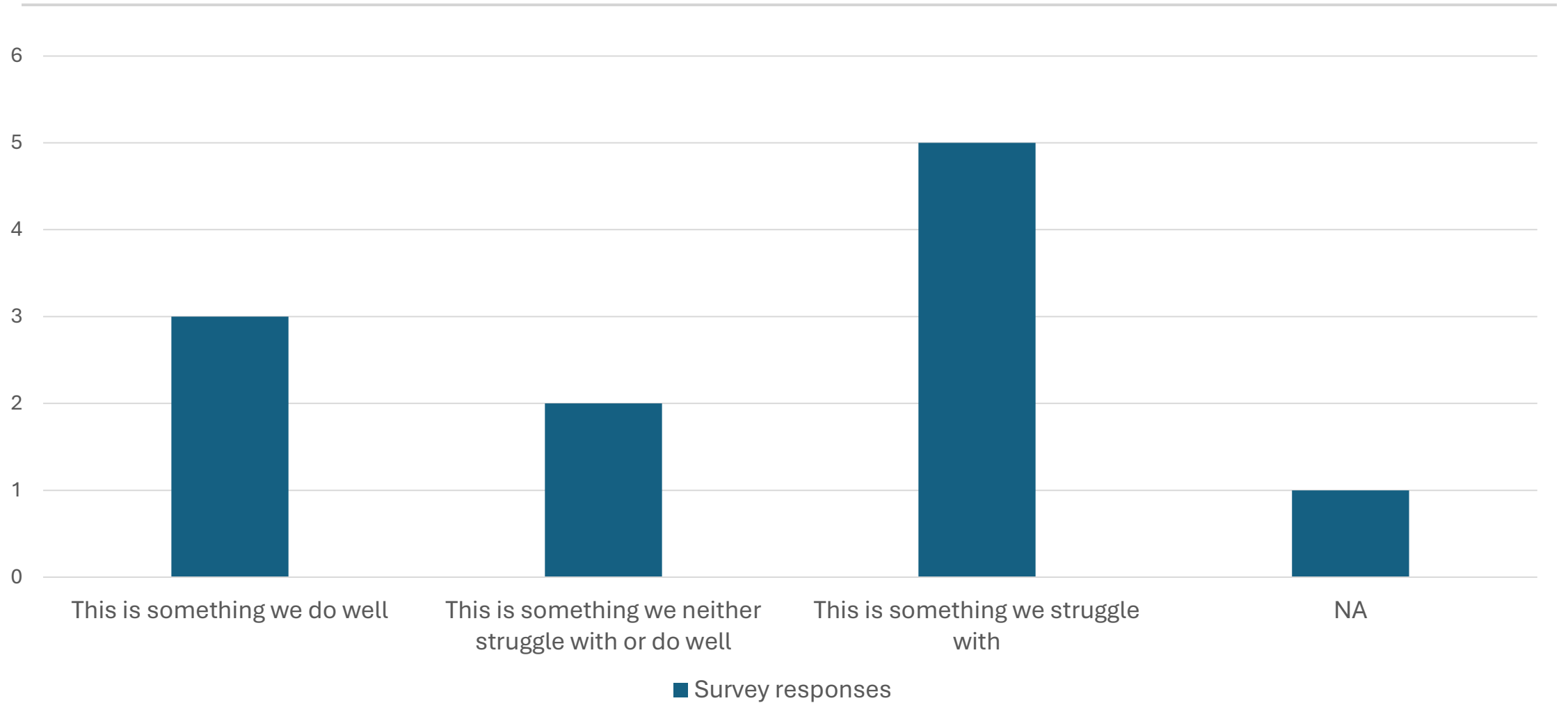

My DPP team is satisfied with the technology it currently uses to send referrals.



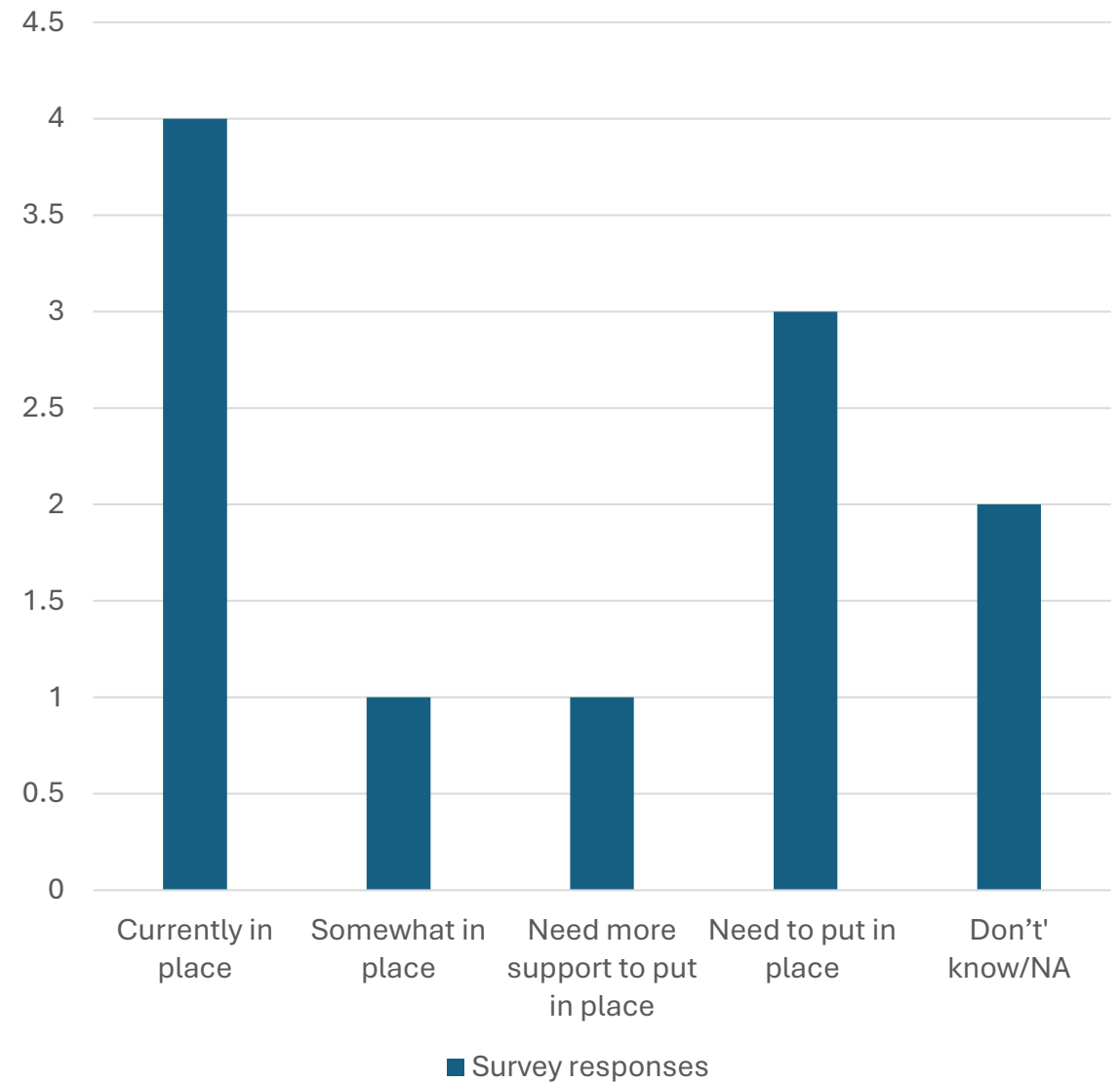
Number of referrals (incoming).



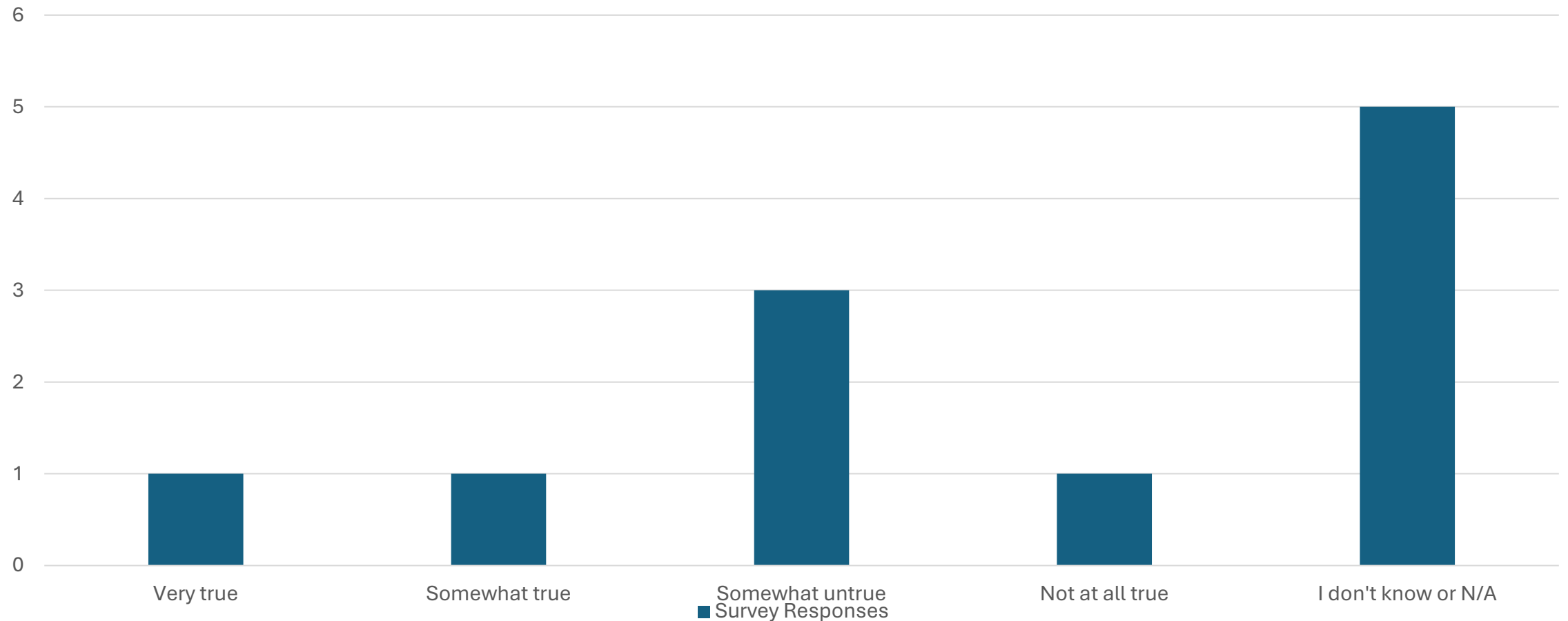

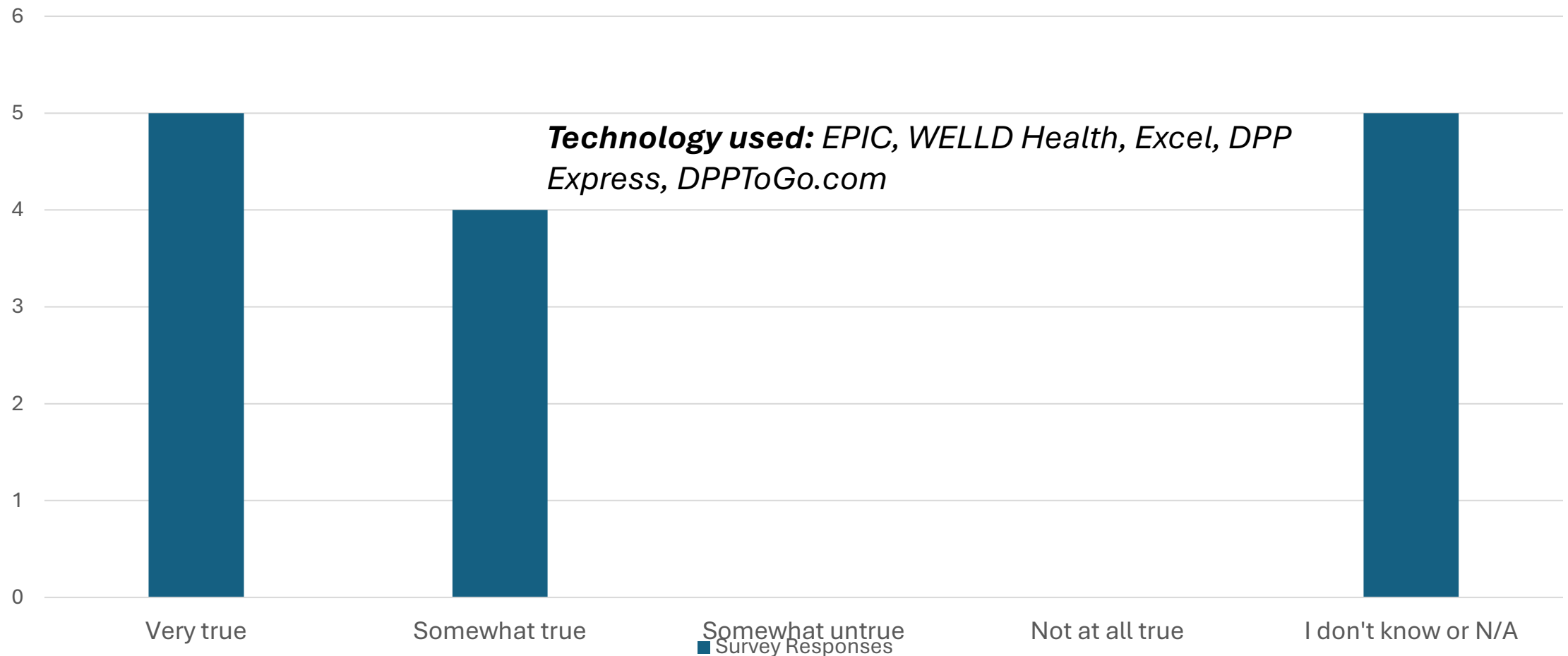

Offering a physical activity portion while giving the education. Set up a mini-cycle bike under the desk while they get the education. It does a lot. It helps them get a head start on the goal of at least 150 minutes for the week, gives them confidence to know they can get exercise anytime, helps them know it is easy to get exercise, and so much more.
